SOCIETY ACT

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is "Village Medical Project for Sierra Leone Society".
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - (a) To provide free medical treatment to all villagers and persons in need by qualified medical doctors and medical support staff;
 - (b) To give special attention to vulnerable target groups particularly, pregnant women, infants and those under five years of age;
 - (c) To provide general healthcare education, through public health teaching, midwife interviews and teaching; and
 - (d) To design and implement community health programs and educate and implement skilled health care workers.
3. The Village Medical Project for Sierra Leone shall be carried on as a society without purpose of gain for its members. Any profits or other gains to the organization shall be used in promoting its objectives and relevant expenses. This provision is unalterable.
4. If, upon winding up or dissolution of the Society in accordance with the provisions of the Society Act of British Columbia, there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, that property shall not be paid to or distributed among the members, but shall be given or transferred to some other Canadian charitable organization or organizations having similar objects, provided that such organization is a charitable organization within the meaning of the Income Tax Act for the time being in force. Such organization or organizations shall be determined by a majority of members attending the first meeting called on the winding up or dissolution of the Society. This provision is unalterable.
